## Clay (Kitty Litter)

- One 2 cu. ft. bag of XSORB will absorb more than five (30 lb.) bags of Clay.
- Delayed absorption time of 15 to 30 minutes means clay is left to soak up the spill, often becoming a hazard to workers, drains and machinery.
- May cause cancer and silicosis.
- May leave a slick residue behind.
- Clay bags can weigh up to 50 lb., causing difficulty in lifting and increasing potential for injury.

## Diatomaceous Earth (D.E.)

- One 2 cu. ft. bag of XSORB will absorb more than 4-5 (35 lb.) bags of D.E.
- Declared toxic by the N.W.F.F. \*
- May cause silicosis and cancer.
- Not for use with organic products.
- May leave slick residue behind.
- D.E. bags weigh up to 35 lb., causing difficulty in lifting and increasing potential for injury.
